Take pride in our fields, clean up after yourself when you leave. Please remind your guests that

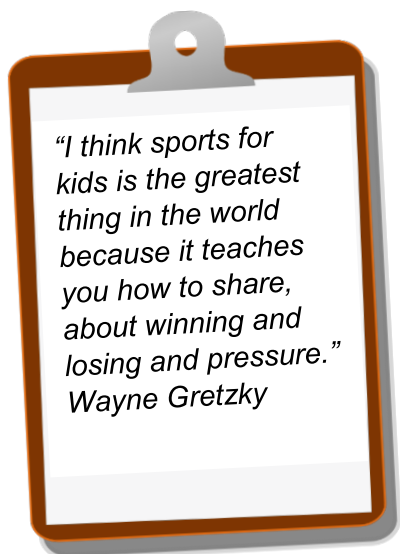
AYS has a NO SMOKING and NO DOGS policy on or near the fields. (Including Vape's)
